

# TEXAS WEEKLY SUMMARY

Week Ending July 14, 2018

Receipts: This Week 51,400 Two Weeks Ago: 23,500 Year Ago 38,600

Compared to sales two weeks ago: Feeder steers and heifers sold mostly firm to 4.00 higher. Trade was fairly active on moderate to good demand as markets started out sluggish after the holiday but picked up momentum by the end of the week. Slaughter cows and bulls steady. All classes of hay traded mostly steady to 5.00 higher. Movement was light to moderate as supply remains low and demand high. In the Texas High Plains grain markets the bulk of bids were mostly 6 to 9 cents lower on grain sorghum; mostly 2 to 11 cents higher on wheat; Mostly steady at 5 cents lower on corn.

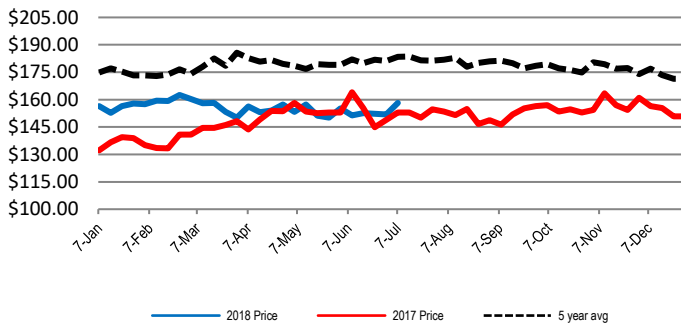

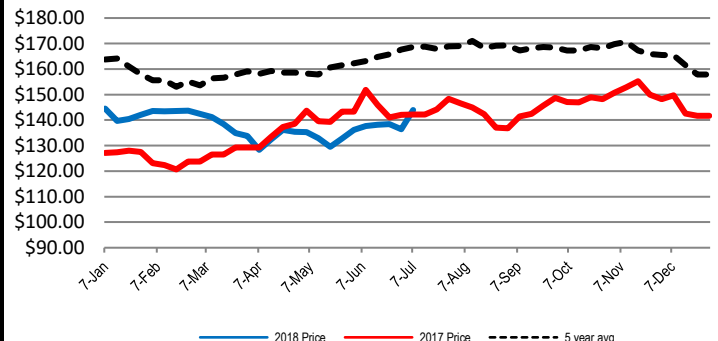
### WEEKLY 600 LB STEER PRICE M&L 1, 1-2, 2
