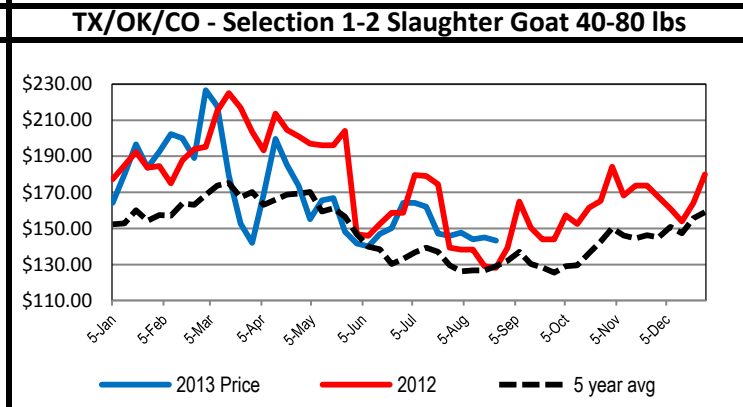
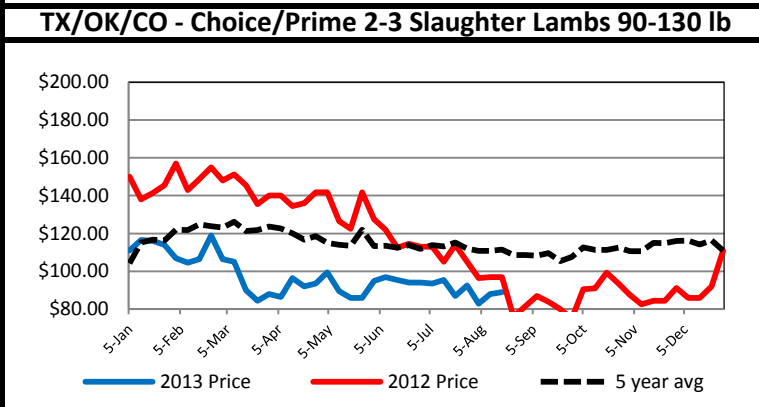

Compared to last week: Slaughter lambs were 5.00-10.00 higher with instances at San Angelo 15.00-20.00 higher on lambs under 60 lbs. Feeder lambs were steady to 5.00 higher. Slaughter ewes were weak at San Angelo, however at Ft Collins they were steady to 7.00 higher. Slaughter kids were mostly steady. Slaughter nannies were steady to 5.00 higher. Trade activity and demand were moderate to good. This week's supply consisted of 43 percent sheep and 57 percent goats at the sales in San Angelo, TX and Ft Collins, CO. ***This report will be discontinued until further notice***
