[National Broiler Market-at-a-Glance](#) - Domestic Market Highlights

Whole broiler/fryer prices are trending steady for whole fryers and wogs. Retail and foodservice demand is mostly moderate. Supplies are sufficient for whole fryers and wogs. Demand is light to moderate, processing schedules normal. Floor stocks are adequate. Prices continue to trend firm for boneless skinless breasts, tenders and smaller sized wings; jumbo sizes and cut wings are steady. Thighs and legs are trending firm. Fronts and other dark meat parts are steady. Supplies are close balance to short of needs for boneless breast and tenders. The balance of parts are clearing satisfactorily. Market activity is moderate to active. In production areas, live supplies are moderate. Weights are mostly desirable. Export demand is moderate.

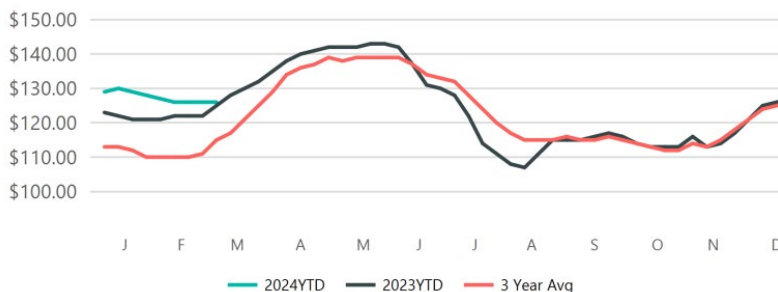

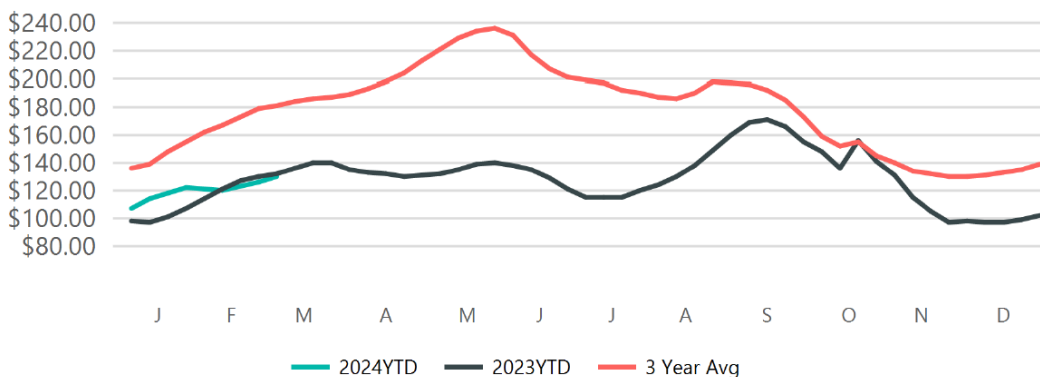
