**SECTION 1 - SELLING CHARGES**

Cow & Calf Pairs	4% of gross value (minimum of \$11.50 per pair)
Bulls	4% of gross value (minimum of \$10.00 per head)
Sheep and Goats	10% of gross value (minimum of \$3.00 per head)
Beef Check-off	\$2.00 (a head)
Yardage	\$2.00 (a head)

**SECTION 2 - RESALES AND NO SALES**

A. Cattle - No sale	\$10.00
Resale	2% of gross sale
B. Sheep and Goats - No sale	\$3.00 per head
Horse - No sale	\$15.00 per head
Resale	1/2 of commission classification

**SECTION 3 - FEED**

Purchased and fed by stockyard:	
Bale of Hay	Cost plus \$2.00 per bale
Sack of Feed	Cost plus \$3.00 per sack

**SECTION 4 - VETERINARY INSPECTION**

The schedule of charges on all necessary veterinary services performed by an accredited veterinarian will be posted uniform per head rates, pursuant to company agreement with the veterinarians performing such services and does not contain any charges retained by the market.

**SECTION 5 - SPECIAL SALES OR SERVICES**

Special sales or unusual stockyard services, such as are included in featured registered cattle and calf sales, annual 4-H sales, and sales for one consignor held on other than regular sale days which require special services and handling will be charted for under special arrangements agreed to between the parties prior to the sale.

**SECTION 6 - INSURANCE**

The schedule of charges will be at rates pursuant to an insurance policy on file with the livestock market and does not contain any charges retained by the insured market.

**SECTION 7 - GENERAL PROVISIONS**

A. ALLOCATION OF PENS

All pens, chutes, and alleys are the property of the marketing business and may not be claimed by a selling or buying customer for his exclusive use. The management of the marketing business will assign all pens and may change such assignment without advance notice.

B. TITLE OF LIVESTOCK

Title to all livestock entrusted to the marketing business for sale remains the owners until the time sold. Time of sale shall be at the time the highest bid is accepted unless the sale is conditional or unless proof of title in the consignor fails.
