Cattle (except cows, pairs, and bulls over 800#)	\$13.00/head
Cows	1.5% of gross sale, Minimum charge - \$15.00
Pairs	1.5% of gross sale, Minimum charge - \$32.50
Bulls over 800#	2% of gross sale, Minimum charge - \$27.50
Sheep and Goats	\$5.00/head
Horses	7% of gross sale Minimum charge - \$10.00

Section 2: Yardage

All cattle	\$5.00/head
Sheep and Goats	\$1.00/head
Horses	\$5.00/head

Section 3 & 4: Veterinary Inspection/Services

The schedule of charges on all necessary veterinary services performed by an accredited veterinarian will be posted at uniform per head rates, pursuant to company agreement with the veterinarian performing such services and does not contain any charges retained by the market.

Section 5: Feed

All feed, as fed, shall be charged for at cost, f.o.b. the market, plus labor.

Section 6: Loss Protection for Livestock
