

**Effective:**

- Section 1. Selling Commission**
- A. Cattle 3% gross sales \$20.00/hd minimum
  - B. CPH Special Feeder Calf Sales 3% gross sales \$20.00/hd minimum
  - C. Sheep & Goats \$4.25/hd
- Section 2. No Sales**
- A. Sheep & Goats \$2.00/hd
- Section 3. Yardage**
- A. Cattle & Calves \$3.00/hd
  - B. Slaughter Cows \$5.00/hd
  - C. Head Cows \$10.00/hd
  - D. Slaughter Bulls \$10.00/hd
- Section 4. Feed**
- A. All feed, as fed, shall be charged for at cost f.o.b. the market business.
- Section 5. Insurance**
- A. Livestock .002 of gross sales
    - 1. plus 11.8% on premium for Kentucky Local Government Tax with state & county
  - B. Payment .00063 of gross sales
- Section 6. Veterinary Services**
- A. The schedule of charges on all necessary veterinary services performed by an accredited veterinarian will be at postal uniform per head rates, pursuant to company agreements with the veterinarian performing such services and does not contain any charges retained by the market.
- Section 7. Special or Unusual Services**
- A. Special sales & marketing service, such as involved in featured registered cattle and calf sales, not usually required in handling livestock for sale and other than specified, will be charged for under special arrangement.
- Section 8. Other Charges & Fees**
- A. Check Off money will be collected as stated by Federal and State law.
