AMA FEE SCHEDULE

Effective Date: January 1, 2024

Regular Hours: ABERDEEN LAB

Service Hours (Including Inspection and Sampling) - 4:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M.

Monday through Friday

Contact lab by 9:00 A.M. for same day inspection service.

Contact lab by Noon on weekdays for on-site inspection service that starts before the end of regular hours the following business day. Provide a minimum of 8 hours notice if service request is made during regular hours.

Contact lab by 10:00 A.M. on Friday for weekend inspection service and 10:00 A.M. the last business day before a holiday for holiday inspection service.

Sampling Only Hours – 7:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. Monday through Friday

Contact lab by 10:00 A.M. for same day sampling service and by 10:00 A.M. Friday for weekend sampling service and 10:00 A.M. the last business day before a holiday for holiday sampling service.

MITCHELL LAB

Inspection and sampling hours – 7:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. Monday through Friday.

Contact lab for service by 4:00 P.M. Previous Business Day.

Regular hourly rates \$26.74 per hour sampler/technician; \$38.33 Inspector.

Cancellation Charges: If service is scheduled and the elevator cancels or changes the service request, a 4-hour person fee shall be assessed.

Overtime hourly rates shall be one and one-half times the regular hourly rate for sampler/technicians and inspectors, in addition to unit fees, for all hourly charges after 8 hours or outside regular hours. A minimum of four hours will be charged if not directly preceding or following core business hours. Per diem, per person, meals \$9.00 per meal for work performed during the following times 6:00 A.M./Noon/6:00 P.M. and actual cost, per hotel room when necessary.

All hourly rates will be assessed in one-half hour increments.



Sunday and Holiday Hourly Rate: \$53.48 per hour sampler/technician and \$76.66 per inspector will be assessed from departure until return to lab in addition to unit fees. Holidays include Martin Luther King’s, Presidents, Good Friday, Memorial, Juneteenth Independence, Labor, Columbus, Veteran’s, and Thanksgiving Day and the Friday after; Christmas Eve P.M. hours and Christmas Day; and New Year’s Eve P.M. hours and New Year’s Day; and Holidays observed by the Minneapolis Grain Exchange. Holidays falling on a Saturday are also observed the Friday before the Holiday. Holidays falling on Sunday are also observed on the following Monday.

Mileage Fees: The IRS standard mileage rate will be accessed for all services performed basis portal to portal. Any change to the mileage rate is effective when the IRS changes their standard mileage rate.

Weather Policy: Aberdeen Grain Inspection will adhere to the following inclement weather policy, railcar sampling services may be delayed or suspended when one or more of the following conditions exist:

High winds, rainfall that creates conditions that are either dangerous to employees and/or degrading to the grain being sampled, lightning, snow and/or ice on the railcars, or any other weather related and/or facility specific condition that could put employees providing the sampling service in jeopardy. Adequate lighting must be provided when onsite sampling is requested after sunset. Travel is suspended when Safe Travel USA shows “No Travel Advised” or “Closed” or similar road conditions are expected.

*The shipper (applicant) is responsible to ensure that all seals are the correct type, applied correctly, and that seal numbers applied match the log and/or certificate prior to releasing the railcars, trucks, totes, lot, etc. Video recording seal numbers and identification, by the shipper prior to releasing the railcars, trucks, totes, lot, etc. for documentation is recommended.



In the event the applicant desires the top of the railcar to be sealed by official AGI personnel, AGI reserves the right to request that the applicant shuts and latches doors after sampling, prior to sealing.

Requests for service after cutoff time (listed on page one) may (1) have to wait for regular hours, (2) be subject to sampling only (for on-site service), or (3) be assessed a 4-hour charge at Aberdeen Grain Inspection, Inc. management discretion (depending on availability of personnel).

Official commercial inspections are available and will be negotiated on a case-by-case basis.

Commodity Cooperative Service Agreement Fees. In addition to all other applicable fees, commodity cooperative service agreement fees for commodity inspection services (pulses, hops, and miscellaneous processed commodities), excluding rice, will be assessed at the current percentage rate identified in FGIS Directive 9180.74 (Service Fees and Billing Codes, Attachment 4.) The assessed fees must exclude travel, mailing expenses, and state and local taxes. Invoices will identify assessed commodity cooperative service agreement fees as separate line items.



AMA Rice Cooperative Service Agreement Fees. In addition to all other applicable fees, AMA rice cooperative service agreements fees for rice inspection services will be assessed at the current percentage rate identified in FGIS Directive 9180.74 (Service Fees and Billing Codes, Attachment 3.) The assessed fees must exclude travel, mailing expenses, and state and local taxes. Invoices will identify assessed AMA rice cooperative service agreement fees as separate line items.

Aberdeen Grain Inspection, Inc. charges are subject to all applicable federal, state, and local service (sales) taxes. Interest on unpaid balances up to 1% per month.
