Effective Date: January 1st, 2024. "Federal Grain Inspection Service (FGIS) must approve all fees for official services and official agencies will assess only fees appearing on their current approved fee schedule.

Regular hours: Monday thru Friday except holidays

7:00am-3:30pm Urbana, Hoopeston, Curran, Marshall, Reddick, IL offices

7:00am-3:30pm Morocco, IN office (local time zone)

All requests for service should be ordered by 3:00 pm the preceding day or the proceeding Friday for the weekend and Monday.

Hourly rates will be charged in quarter hour increments. All overtime, Sunday, and holiday rates will be assessed in addition to unit fees. Overtime will be assessed for all work performed outside regular hours. A minimum call out charge of four (4) hours will be assessed at applicable hourly rate outside regular business hours.

Personnel Safety:

It is the customer's responsibility to make the grain, commodity, or stowage area safely accessible. Agency employees do not open or close doors or lids on railcars or shipping containers. There must be a minimum of two people at all times on top of railcars and in the immediate vicinity at facilities where services are being performed. This can be two agency employees or one agency employee and one customer employee. This is to "render aid if needed" or to

call for assistance.

Weather Policy:

Agency will adhere to the following inclement weather policy: Sampling and stowage examination requests may be delayed, curtailed, or dismissed when any of the following conditions exist: High winds, rainfall, snow, ice and other conditions that are dangerous to employee and/or facility specific conditions that

could put employees providing services in jeopardy. Adequate lighting must be provided when onsite services are requested after sunset.

Holidays:

New Year's Eve, New Year's Day, President's Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. Holidays which fall on Saturday will be it celebrated on the preceding Friday, those which fall on Sunday will be celebrated on the following Monday.

On call charges:

On call charges occur when an applicant requests personnel to be available outside regular business hours. Elevator must establish a start / notification time for agency personnel to be available for work. If the work is not performed at this time and personnel are requested to continue on call waiting for a return notification of work, a charge of two (2) hours at the applicable rate of pay will be charged to the requesting facility.

Travel time will be charged for all travel during regular business hours. Applicable hourly rate per employee, per trip, in quarter hour increments or fraction of based on mileage traveled.

Mileage Rate:

The IRS standard mileage rate will be assessed for all services performed basis portal to portal. Any change to the mileage rate is effective when the IRS changes their standard mileage rate. Mileage will be prorated when more than one elevator per trip.

- FGIS Administrative Tonnage Fees. In addition to all other applicable fees, FGIS administrative tonnage fees
 for export grain shipments inspected and/or weighed, excluding land carrier shipments to Canada and
 Mexico, will be assessed at the current per metric ton rate identified in FGIS Directive 9180.74 Service Fees
 and Billing Codes, Attachment 1. Invoices will identify assessed administrative tonnage fees as separate line
 items per applicable carrier/unit type.
- **FGIS Supervision Fees.** In addition to all other applicable fees, FGIS supervision fees for domestic U.S. grain shipments inspected and/or weighed, including land carrier shipments to Canada and Mexico, will be assessed at the current per metric ton rate identified in FGIS Directive 9180.74 Service Fees and Billing Codes, Attachment 2. Invoices will identify assessed supervision fees as separate line items per applicable carrier/unit type.

On-site inspection service:

Applicable hourly rate per person plus unit fee if personnel are available. Champaign Danville Grain Inspection reserves the right to determine the number of personnel to properly service the customer. Elevator will be charged at the hourly rate of one (1) railcar per quarter (1/4) hour of standby time.
