AMA FEE SCHEDULE

Services Performed under Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946

Effective Date: January 1, 2024- Federal Grain Inspection Service (FGIS) must approve all fees for official services and official agencies will assess only those fees appearing on their current approved fee schedule

Regular Hours: 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday thru Friday **EXCEPT** holidays.

Regular, Standby, Travel, Overtime, Sunday, & Holiday Hourly Rates: Assessed in half-hour increments per individual necessary to perform the service and a minimum of 2 hours per person will be assessed.

Inspectors/Sampler

Regular.....	\$33.00
Saturday & other than regular weekly hours.....	\$49.50
Sunday & Holidays.....	\$66.00

Standby/Travel, above applicable rate applies. Overtime & Holiday rates applied in addition to unit fees. New Year’s Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, ½ day to be observed after noon the day after Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve after noon, Christmas Day, and New Year’s Eve after noon. Holidays which fall on Saturday will be observed on preceding Friday; those which fall on Sunday will be observed on following Monday.

Minimum of 4 hours per person assessed for outside of regular hours if not directly preceding or following regular business hours.

Hastings Grain Inspection reserves the right to determine the number of inspection personnel to properly service the customer.

Mileage Rate: IRS standard rate will be assessed for actual miles traveled. Any change to the mileage rate is effective when the IRS changes their standard mileage rate.

Inspection Services

Sampling, mileage, postage, and delivery charges are in addition to unit fees listed. Sampler, travel, and or standby time will be assessed at applicable hourly rates and mileage will be assessed for all services. Travel time will be assessed portal to portal. All requests for service should be ordered by 2:00pm the preceding Friday for the weekend.

Commodity Cooperative Service Agreement Fees. In addition to all other applicable fees, commodity cooperative service agreement fees for commodity inspection services (pulses, hops, and miscellaneous processed commodities), excluding rice, will be assessed at the current percentage rate identified in FGIS Directive 9180.74 (Service Fees and Billing Codes, Attachment 4.) The assessed fees must exclude travel, mailing expenses, and state and local taxes. Invoices will identify assessed commodity cooperative service agreement fees as separate line items.
