FEES and CHARGES

Effective: **March 1, 2024**

“Federal Grain Inspection Service (FGIS) must approve all fees for official services and official agencies will assess only those fees appearing on their current approved fee schedule.”

DEFINITIONS

1. “Regular hours” means 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. All hourly fees will be assessed in quarter-hour increments, per individual necessary to perform the service. The regular hourly rate will be charged at \$26.00 per hour for a sampler/technician. The hourly rate for an inspector will be charged at \$32.00 per hour.
2. “Overtime” means work performed during any hour other than the regular hours or holiday hours as defined. Overtime hourly rate will be charged at \$39.00 per hour for a sampler/technician. The hourly rate for an inspector will be charged at \$48.00 per hour.
3. “Travel time” means time spent in round trip travel from portal to portal. If an employee performs inspections at several locations on one trip, travel time may be prorated and the appropriate hourly rate will applied.
4. “Holidays” means:

Sundays and the following Holidays:

New Year’s Day
Labor Day

Memorial Day
Thanksgiving Day

Fourth of July
Christmas Day

Holiday/Sunday hourly rate will be charged at \$52.00 per hour for a sampler/technician. The hourly rate for an inspector will be charged at \$64.00 per hour.

5. “Standby time” means idle time spent at customer facility due to customer-caused delays. Standby time will be charged at the applicable hourly rate.
6. “On-Call Charges” is when an applicant requests personnel to be available outside regular business hours. Personnel are off-site waiting to report for duty.
Elevator
must establish a starting time for KGIS personnel to be available for work. Elevator personnel will contact KGIS personnel before the starting time to report on the loading status. If the elevator is not ready, an on-call charge of two hours per person will be assessed at the applicable hourly rate. No more than two

on-call charges per person per day will be assessed.

The appropriate hourly rate will be applied for sampling services.

Mileage: The IRS standard mileage rate will be assessed for all services performed outside the service point city’s limit. Any charge to the mileage rate is effective when the IRS changes their standard mileage rate. Mileage will be prorated when possible.

Credit Card Fee: Direct pass through of credit card charge from credit card processor if credit card is used.

The following fees will be charged for services rendered by this agency under the U.S. Grain Standards Act.

- **FGIS Administrative Tonnage Fees.** In addition to all other applicable fees, FGIS administrative tonnage fees for export grain shipments inspected and/or weighed, excluding land carrier shipments to Canada and Mexico, will be assessed at the current per metric ton rate identified in FGIS Directive 9180.74 Service Fees and Billing Codes, Attachment 1. Invoices will identify assessed administrative tonnage fees as separate line items per applicable carrier/unit type.
- **FGIS Supervision Fees.** In addition to all other applicable fees, FGIS supervision fees for domestic U.S. grain shipments inspected and/or weighed, including land carrier shipments to Canada and Mexico, will be assessed at the current per metric ton rate identified in FGIS Directive 9180.74 Service Fees and Billing Codes, Attachment 2. Invoices will identify assessed supervision fees as separate line items per applicable carrier/unit type.

Official commercial inspection service is provided upon agreement between Kansas Grain Inspection Service, Inc and the applicant. Fees charged are dependent upon modification to the service. Inquiries should be forwarded to the Kansas Grain Inspection Service, Inc. (KGIS), P.O. Box 750077, Topeka, Kansas 66675.

When no fee for service has been established, the hourly rate will apply.

Interest will be assessed on unpaid accounts which are in excess of 60 days. The rate of interest charged will be set by the KGIS trustees and will not exceed 18% A.P.R.

Per Diem Expenses: \$24 per day, per individual, plus actual lodging expense, when required to stay overnight away from main office location.
