# **OFFICIAL FEE SCHEDULE**

**EFFECTIVE DATE**: Effective February 15, 2022. This fee schedule supersedes all other fee schedules issued by State Grain Inspection. The fees set forth in this schedule relate to sampling, inspection, weighing and other official services and certification performed by State Grain Inspection under the United States Grain Standards Act. Federal Grain Inspection must approve all fees for official services and official agencies will assess only those fees appearing on their current approved fee schedule. The FGIS user fees have been suspended for an indefinite time and are reflected.

MAIN OFFICE HOURS: Monday through Friday 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. except holidays.

**OVERTIME HOURS**: Charges are at time and one half for services, Monday through Friday, before 6:00 AM., after 5:00 PM., after 8.0 hours per day, and Saturdays. Sundays and Holidays are charged at double the regular rate.

All rates are per hour and assessed in one-half hour increments. A minimum of three hours for service will be charged at the applicable hourly rate during regular hours. A minimum of four hours applies to hours outside regular service hours. Hourly rates will be charged, at one and one-half times the applicable hourly rate for sampling if the following minimums are not met: an average of: 3 railcars per hour or 2 containers per hour.

**Minimum Hourly call out rates**: Minimum 2 hours per person at applicable rate will apply for under 4 hour notice of cancellation or request. State Grain Inspections reserves the right to determine the number and type of personnel to properly service the customer.

**Call Charges:** Call out, on call (Personnel are off site waiting to report for duty.), or back to work will be assessed a 4- hour minimum per person at the applicable hourly rate.

**HOLIDAYS**: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day.

**MILEAGE FEES**: The Internal Revenue Service standard rate will be assessed for actual miles traveled to perform services that are more than 5 miles from the Savage office (or the nearest full time staffed office). Mileage rate will change when IRS standard rate changes.

**FGIS** Administrative Tonnage Fees: In addition to all other applicable fees, FGIS administrative tonnage fees for export grain shipments inspected and/or weighed, excluding land carrier shipments to Canada and Mexico, will be assessed at the current per metric ton rate identified in FGIS Directive 9180.74 Service Fees and Billing Codes, Attachment 1. Invoices will identify assessed administrative tonnage fees as separate line items per applicable carrier/unit type.

**FGIS Supervision Fees:** In addition to all other applicable fees, FGIS supervision fees for domestic U.S. grain shipments inspected and/or weighed, including land carrier shipments to Canada and Mexico, will be assessed at the current per metric ton rate identified in FGIS Directive 9180.74 Service Fees and Billing Codes, Attachment 2. Invoices will identify assessed supervision fees as separate line items per applicable carrier/unit type.

Official Commercial Inspection services are available and negotiated on a case by case basis.

All other official services not covered in this fee schedule will be charged at the appropriate hourly rate.


