# **Transcript: Instructions to Propose Corrections**

These Instructions concern the Hearing on proposed amendments to pricing formulas in all 11 Federal Milk Marketing Orders ("FMMOs"), filed as Docket No. 23-J-0067; AMS-DA-23-0031, In re: Milk in the Northeast and Other Marketing Areas. Hearing transcripts for all 49 days of the FMMO Pricing Hearing were posted by February 21, 2024, to the USDA / Agricultural Marketing Service ("AMS") hearing webpage at:

https://www.ams.usda.gov/rules-regulations/moa/dairy/hearings/national-fmmo-pricinghearing/transcripts

The 30<sup>th</sup> day thereafter is March 22, 2024. Therefore, corrections to the transcript must be received by March 22, 2024. *See* 7 C.F.R. § 900.27(a).

The judge will review all timely submitted proposed transcript corrections and, after due consideration, will issue an order making any corrections to the transcript that the judge finds are warranted. Corrections are NOT appropriate if offered to improve witness testimony or to correct the witness's error in testimony or exhibit. Briefs are the appropriate place for that. Obvious typographical errors need not be addressed. Wrong spellings of names and inaccurate descriptions or references to exhibits should be addressed. *See* 7 C.F.R. § 1.142(a); *see also* 7 C.F.R. § 900.10. To be considered, proposed transcript corrections will be submitted BOTH (1) by email to <u>FMMOHearing@usda.gov</u> AND (2) by filing with the USDA Hearing Clerk (see below).

## 1. Email to <u>FMMOHearing@usda.gov</u>

Go to the USDA / AMS webpage below and follow the instructions to send by **5:00 pm Eastern on March 22, 2024**, all proposed transcript corrections to <u>FMMOHearing@usda.gov</u> using the template for corrections included as an attachment to this Order.

## 2. File with the Hearing Clerk:

The deadline to file proposed transcript corrections with the USDA Hearing Clerk is onehalf-hour earlier, to meet the March 22, 2024 deadline (7 C.F.R. § 900.27). To file with the Hearing Clerk, proposed transcript corrections must be RECEIVED by the Hearing Clerk by **4:30 pm Eastern on March 22, 2024**. Proposed transcript corrections can be filed by email or FAX with the Hearing Clerk's Office as further directed below.

The USDA / AMS webpage at

shows the USDA Hearing Clerk's correct contact information under Hearing Concluded, including email address. An error is present in the transcript for the email address for the Hearing Clerk.

The most efficient way to file with the Hearing Clerk is to attach a document to an email and send to <u>SM.OHA.HearingClerks@usda.gov</u>, or to FAX the document to 1-844-325-6940 if you prefer. The Hearing Clerk's information can also be found on the USDA / AMS webpage and on the last page of this order. If emailing or FAXing to the Hearing Clerk, submit once (NOT in quadruplicate). My suggestions follow, regarding practical methods of filing with the Hearing Clerk by email attaching "large" attachments; and other possibilities for delivery of "large" documents to the Hearing Clerk for filing.

Individuals or parties interested in filing transcript corrections may file anytime when ready until the times listed above on March 22, 2024.

If the email with attachment(s) is too "large" to send, you may want to attach multiple files and / or send multiple emails each with attachments, which the Hearing Clerk can assemble into one document if that is what you instruct. Some filers may compress their attachments using zip files or folders. Some filers may want to deliver a thumb drive to the Hearing Clerk in person or by courier or an express delivery service. If delivering thumb drive or hard copy filings to the Hearing Clerk's Office, consider additional time needed for delivery to ensure RECEIPT by the deadline.

Some filers may use Box (<u>https://www.box.com/</u>). (The application "box" is NOT the same as the application Dropbox).

The Hearing Clerk, Ms. Caroline Hill, instructs that IF filers have a "box" account to share documents with the Hearing Clerk, they should use the Hearing Clerk's individual email address, NOT <u>sm.oha.HearingClerks@usda.gov</u>, which thus far has not proved successful. Caroline Hill's individual email address is <u>caroline.hill@usda.gov</u>.

If filers want to discuss delivery with the Hearing Clerk, they may use the Hearing Clerk's contact information to ask to confer with Caroline Hill.

During the Hearing the Agricultural Market Service explained the usefulness of electronic versions of exhibits. For example, to ensure that evidence from websites would NOT change, AMS asked that Excel spreadsheets be submitted electronically and "password protected." This online version provides greater accessibility to the public and is therefore better for 508 compliance.

The contact information for the Hearing Clerk is contained on the last page of this order. To meet deadlines, filings must be RECEIVED by the Hearing Clerk by 4:30 pm Eastern on the due date.

Copies of this order "Transcript: Instructions to Propose Corrections" shall be sent by the Hearing Clerk to each of the parties.
