DISCRIMINATION IN EMPLOYMENT IS ILLEGAL!

If you believe you have been discriminated against because of your race, color, religion, sex (including gender identity and expression), national origin, age (if 40 or over), disability, reprisal (for prior participation in an EEO activity or having opposed discrimination), political affiliation, sexual orientation, marital status, parental status, or genetic information, in an employment matter or in the workplace, and wish to initiate an EEO complaint, you must contact your EEO Counselor within 45 days of the alleged discriminatory action.
