COMMODITY SPECIFICATION CANNED FRUIT – September 2014

The purpose of this amendment is to:

- Add exceptions to (CID) to I. General requirements
- Add Order of Precedence for requirements
- Further clarify the Packing, Labels and Packaging requirements for primary containers
- Add new package size/type for applesauce
- Add new item individual serving size applesauce cup contained within a six cup printed sleeve
- Add labeling requirements for 4.0 ounce individual serving size applesauce cup
- Add additional intermediate packaging/labeling (sleeve) requirements for individual serving size applesauce cup packed within a six cup sleeve

I. General

B. Exceptions to U.S. Standards and/or or Commercial Item Description (CID)

Exceptions to the U.S. Standards for the Department of Agriculture (USDA) canned fruit **and/or Commercial Item Description (CID)** are found in Section II, Individual Commodity Specifications, of this document.

1. Order of Precedence

The contract will incorporate the Master Solicitation including: the applicable IFB; the applicable Commodity Specification and/or Supplement; the Contractor's offer; and the Purchase Order. If the contract documents are inconsistent or contradictory, the following order of precedence will prevail: IFB, Master Solicitation, Amendments to Commodity Specifications, Commodity Specifications and/or Supplement(s).

J. Packing, Labels and Packaging

1. Primary Containers

- a) All products must be packed in new, commercially acceptable primary containers which meet all applicable FDA requirements (link to: <u>FDA Food Labeling Regulations</u>). Retail labels must meet minimum requirements as specified in the Master Solicitation.
 - Must meet the minimum FDA labeling requirements
 - Product labeling/packaging must also have at least 2 additional colors other than black and/or white and a visual representation of the product if the container is not clear.

Minimum FDA labeling requirements are:

- Statement of identity, or name of the food
- Net quantity statement
- Ingredient statement
- Manufacturer or distributor location statement
- Allergen declaration (if product contains a major allergen)

The packages must be suitably code marked so that the product can be identified with related inspection certificates and to insure traceability in the event of a recall.

II. Individual Commodity Specifications

A. Applesauce

- 6. Net Weight
 - **a.** No. 300 size cans must average not less than 15.0 ounces, provided no individual sample has a net weight less than 14.5 ounces.
 - b. 12/23 ounce plastic bottle with screw top lid

Applesauce in Individual Serving Sizes

- 1. Grade U.S. Grade A.
- 2. Color Type Natural.
- 3. Flavor Type Natural flavor.
- 4. Type of Pack Unsweetened.
- 5. Style Regular (comminuted).
- 6. Size of Primary Container Individual portion serving-plastic cups. Cups must be suitably code marked so that the product can be identified with related inspection certificates and to insure traceability in the event of a recall.
- 7. Individual Net Weight.
 - **a.** 4.5 ounces per cup. 96 cups per case (without sleeves).

- 4.5 ounce individual cups must meet all labeling requirements shown in section J. above
- b. 4.0 ounces per cup contained within a commercially acceptable printed sleeve, 6 cups/sleeve, 12 sleeves/72 cups per case.
 - Minimum labeling requirements include Statement of identity, or name of the food, and trace code
 - Color/visual representation on cup label is optional

Printed sleeves must be:

- Commercially labeled (retail/consumer) and contain minimum FDA labeling requirements and include a Nutrition Facts Panel
- Must at a minimum have 2 additional colors other than black and/or white and a visual representation of the product
