Discussion

- Guest speaker: Lindsay Haines, USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS). Transition to Organic. The Subcommittee welcomed Lindsay Haines, and relayed background about the NOSB and NOP relationship, and the Board's role in the transition to organic. Lindsay discussed the role of NRCS in relation to the TOPP project, as well as successes, and challenges. Successes include such things as training and outreach, and working with certifiers. Challenges include NRCS staff members' lack of experience and knowledge about organic production, resistance to standards, lack of criteria (different than NRCSs), and decentralization of the organization. The NRCS is looking to broaden its collaboration network with certifiers farmers. The Organic Transition Initiative (OTI) is a priority for NRCS through 2027, and Lindsay highlighted a funding opportunity that they managed to post as a National deadline of March 1 (rather than regional or state-level deadlines, which may be different and adds confusion). Lindsay also presented a list of needs and opportunities: more technical service providers (TSPs), assistance with communicating opportunities for funding (OTI, EQIP, AMS, CSP), training https://conservationwebinars.net/, OLPS rule, internal training for NRCS staff, coordination with TOPP. She emphasized that NRCS doesn't want to conflict with TOPP mentors who are already funded to provide guidance. Members asked follow-up questions and the group ended with a discussion about ways to improve communication and outreach. Lindsay also noted that if folks are seeking information, it's best to start at their local office, and if they can't answer your questions, to elevate it to regional and then state, if needed.

Discussion

- September 12, 2023 notes were accepted with minor revisions.
- New support staff. The CACS welcomed the newest NOSB technical support staff member.
- **Discuss public comments (All).** The CACS reviewed the Fall meeting agenda and briefly discussed timing for discussions. A member asked about the process for the discussion documents and whether they will end up as proposals for the next meeting. It's possible and depends on public feedback and Board discussion.
- **Guest speaker.** The CACS discussed questions for Francie Tolle, (USDA Risk Management Agency) who was invited to speak at the fall meeting on the topic of crop insurance. Members suggested questions ranging from general thoughts about the discussion document, to price and yield data needs, to the relationship between RMA, NOP, and other agencies. A member added that there may be conflict between the organic regulations and what RMA considers good farming practices, and maybe there is room to discuss Organic System Plans (OSPs) and how to incorporate that into RMA guidance. A member mentioned draft Senate Bill 98, the Agriculture Advancement Act, for which data collection has occurred, and suggested working with other groups who may have data-collection-best-practices.
- **SOE town hall (KS).** A member reported on an SOE town hall meeting that she was participating in. There were seven producers in attendance, and they asked good questions on a range of topics. In the farming community, the non-retail container labeling requirement is the part of SOE where farmers have the most questions. The town hall also focused on recordkeeping for mass balance and traceback audits.
- Weed Management (NL). The Crops Subcommittee discussed the BBMF work agenda request earlier today and has chosen to not revisit the topic at this time. The Subcommittee Chair will send a response to the NOP soon. Given that decision, the CACS will not pursue the weed management topic at this time, as they want to work on those topics in tandem. They may revisit this at a later date if it can be recoupled with BBMF as part of the BBMF sunset review or annotation change process. The group also talked about innovation, and the idea of solutions outside of BBMF.
- Additional Items.
 - Handling standards. The group will continue exploring the possibility of a new work agenda items related to handling standards after members finish taking the Organic Integrity Learning Center (OILC) training on "Keeping It Organic". A member suggested that this work agenda topic could also address post-harvest handling standards or guidance, to help improve consistency for

certifiers in evaluating substances and practices that occur after harvest and prior to further processing.

- SOE and Retailers. A member discussed the issue of large retailers perhaps not being able to meet the March 2024 implementation deadline, and whether or not they have a "soft landing" and a path to certification after that date. NOP is doing direct outreach to affected entities, and has asked that stakeholders identify anyone that should be included on that contact list. The CACS will ask NOP at the NOSB meeting about whether NOP will take a risk-based approach to assessing compliance after the SOE implementation date. A member identified one category of operation that he finds concerning, and that is a small-to-medium-sized distributors.

Discussion

- September 5, 2023 notes were accepted as written.
- NOSB Technical representative introduction. Heather Kumar is the new NOSB technical representative/ food technologist. Heather has been with the NOP for over a year and has a graduate degree in Food Safety Regulations, and has worked as a chemistry teacher and a lab technician.
- **Potential Work Agenda Items Review.** The CACS had a brainstorming session on its last call about potential work agenda items and revisited the topics.
 - a. Follow-up on handling standards post-SOE training (KS). Deferred to next call.
 - **b.** Ideas on a processed-based approach for plastics (NL). The NOP recently sent a memo to the Board asking them to revisit the previous NOSB recommendation on BBMF. The Crops Subcommittee received the work agenda item, and in parallel, the CACS is considering a potential framework to work on plastic more broadly across the organic system plan. A member suggested perhaps focusing on plastic as it relates to the weed management practice standards at §205.206 since that fits squarely in the purview of the NOSB. The lead will write a paragraph requesting a work agenda item, will share it with other members for wordsmithing, then forward it to the Executive team to discuss on the September 19 Executive call. Several members offered to assist/ support the leads. The group also discussed divvying up the 7 questions in the BBMF memo and having CACS address some of them, because they seem broader than just Crops.
 - c. Ideas on developing a framework for sharing organic community challenges/solutions with other agencies (NL). As discussed last week, the group considered whether to use the crop insurance and research priorities proposals as a model for other issues such as cost-share. The CACS is seeking a framework or process by which they can connect stakeholders to other agencies, for example when stakeholders have concerns or solutions about cost-share, or crop insurance, because the NOSB is frequently seen as a conduit for anything having to do with organic. The group did not decide to advance this work agenda topic, but may revisit cost-share at a later date after the crop insurance document is complete.
 - **d. SOE and retailers (JD).** The lead noted that there wasn't much to add since the last discussion, but he continues to caution that the SOE implementation deadline of March 2024 may not be realistic for some companies. He is advocating for a "soft-landing" and clear guidance about how

to bring some of the entities into compliance if they cannot make the deadline. The CACS Chair previously mentioned the timeline involved in getting fully certified, and indicated that October would be the latest date to get started in order to meet the March 2024 deadline. Another member added that while the NOSB wants to be helpful, it is not the enforcement arm of the program. A member mentioned the recent OIG report regarding SOE:

Discussion

- August 8, 2023 notes were accepted as written.
- Review work agenda/schedule.
 - The CACS reviewed the work agenda, and discussed potential future work agenda items. There are several projects in progress that will be presented at the Spring meeting. The Chair highlighted the Strengthening Organic Enforcement (SOE) rule and possible projects connected to that, such as Oversight improvements to deter fraud: Minimum Reporting Requirements. A member mentioned a new training in the Organic Integrity Learning Center (OILC) regarding SOE called "Keep it Organic When Handling and Processing". She indicated that she would take the training and let the CACS know if there are answers to the question about how or whether SOE will impact organic handlers.

Additional Items.

- The group discussed plastic, which they view as a broad issue that encompasses more than just 0 plastic mulch and covers for crop use. For example, it's a food packaging problem, as well as an agricultural production problem. Members posed questions to the group about whether this is something the NOSB can contribute to in a meaningful way, and what impact the NOSB could make given that the problem is widespread, and largely outside of organic agriculture. A member recommended that if they work on plastic, that it be done in the CACS instead of just Crops, and will think more about possible ways the NOSB could work on this. The NOP will be sending a work agenda request to the Crops Subcommittee soon, asking them to reconsider a previous NOSB recommendation on BBMF, given new information about biodegradability. The group discussed several aspects: community support for addressing this problem; the need for a holistic solution; the value in addressing pieces of the issue on plastic; the acknowledgement of the complexity due to the scope of the problem, most of which is outside of the USDA/NOSB authority. The group questioned whether the work is worth doing if it's outside OFPA's scope, and whether there is a path forward for this issue. A member suggested that if the CACS chooses to work on it, it would be beneficial to take an organic-systems-plan approach. One member noted that in her most recent inspection, her certifier asked specific questions about trash and recycling.
- The group discussed the certification cost share program, and ways to make it more streamlined and more beneficial to farmers who need it. Members shared ideas that other organizations have been proposing, such as reallocating funds based on need to those farmers who see the cost-share as a lifeline; increasing the amount that beginning farmers receive; and making the process easier by giving funds directly to certifiers. A member noted that

certification costs are rising, based on many factors such as transportation costs, staffing increases, etc. This effort could help reduce barriers to transition. The NOSB could characterize the problems and offer some possible solutions. CACS could approach the issue similarly to the crop insurance work agenda item: The Board doesn't need to solve the problem but could be a clearing house for what producers are saying and compile potential solutions. The group talked about developing a framework for how NOSB Recommendations on issues like this are shared with other federal agencies, in this case FSA, using the NOSB Research priorities and NIFA as a model. They may revisit this at a later date. NL will consider ideas for the framework.

- A member relayed concerns that large retailers/distributors will not meet the March 2024 SOE implementation deadline, and were unaware of who to contact for information. He questioned whether there could be an extension on the implementation date, or a soft landing for operations that don't meet the deadline. The CACS may discuss this at the Fall 2023 meeting if the issues are not resolved prior. The group questioned what happens if some entities in the supply chain do not meet the deadline to get certified. Do they receive a non-compliance and an opportunity to correct and come into compliance? A member mentioned that some producers are getting letters from their certifiers about identifying uncertified operations in their supply chain under penalty of fines for not doing so.

The current document includes a proposed framework to evaluate substances for testing, with an initial focus on two aspects: synthetic solvents used in oilseed extraction; and fumigants. It also includes questions to determine if and where gaps may exist. A member added that the timing may be interesting with the implementation date of SOE. The group had a robust conversation about the first iteration of the document. - June 6, 2023 notes were accepted as written.
- **Opportunities in Organic: Support for Transitioning Producers (AJ).** The lead summarized the draft document, and the group discussed the purpose of the document and the questions to stakeholders. The CACS wants to use the responses to guide follow-up actions that may inform recommendations to NOP. This could help to focus resources, and open parallel streams of work on equity and inclusion. A member indicated that there is already a large body of research as to why some operations have chosen to not be certified or have exited from organic transition or certification. A member suggested adding a question about long-term plans for farmers once they become certified. The lead will modify the list of questions based on the conversation, and the group will discuss this again on the next call. The CACS plans to post this in the open docket (AMS-NOP-23-0026) early to allow commenters more time to answer the questions.
- Organic and Climate-Smart Agriculture (Climate/Equity) Climate Induced Farming Risk and Crop Insurance Discussion document. The lead described the draft document she is developing. The document contains a summary of public comment from the last meeting, in which commenters conveyed personal experiences with crop insurance, and will also include a summary of data she gleaned from interviewing organic farmers, non-profits, researchers, and others, which she categorized by areas that were problematic. While there is nothing new or novel, the information is compiled in one place. The CACS will review the draft discussion document on the next call, and vote to send it to the full Board if ready. Members discussed other aspects of Crop insurance and the current drought that is affecting producers.

Discussion

- April 4, 2023 notes were accepted as written.
- Guest speaker NOP Trade Systems Director Jon Veley. Soybean imports and CBP. Jon introduced himself, and the AMS Trade Division. The Trade Division was started in 2016, and Jon was recruited from CBP, who partnered with AMS to work on cargo issues to improve enforcement. AMS has launched a new program on bulk commodities (grain). The Trade Division does unannounced inspections at ports, where they sample and send to the USDA lab in Gastonia, NC for testing. AMS is conducting a number of actions, but often the information isn't released to the public until any court proceedings are completed. Members engaged in Q and A with Jon. A member asked why the current structure or rules might not be stringent enough and why it would need to change. Additionally, if the CACS were to work on the topic of strengthening enforcement with respect to grain, what would the goal of the document be? The group discussed the testing requirement of 5% and ideally would like to see it increased. A member suggested they may want to invite Peyton Ferrier to a future CACS call. Peyton is an economist at USDA, who has expertise in this area of economics, and he could inform them about analyses that factor into decision making, such as testing requirements.
 - A member asked where one could access public information about sampling results. NOP will follow up.
 - Since SOE implementation isn't complete yet, the CACS Chair would like to get ahead of any
 potential issues, and feels that working on a proposal for testing requirements might be an area
 that could use some work. She added that she has read SOE and feels that this could build a
 complimentary pipeline and would rather not wait until there is a problem.
- **Opportunities in Organic: Support for Transitioning Producers (AJ).** The CACS is interested in working on organic transition, and feels that the NOSB could serve as conduit between industry and NOP. The proposed work may contains a 3-pronged approach: 1. Partnership with certifiers 2. Financial support for transitioning farmers; and 3. Market development grants. The CACS would like to move ahead with a discussion document for the Fall meeting that includes discussion of barriers and goals for building a broad and diverse organic community. A member added that the climate document seems to fit under diversity and inclusion and would like to emphasize that they are already working on that piece.
- **Review Public comment.** The CACS briefly discussed public comments.
- Additional Items. The group renamed the Human Capital Management: Support for Transitioning Producers to Opportunities in Organic: Support for Transitioning Producers
 - The CACS asked for a progress report on their previous recommendation for NOSB technical support, and will ask about that during the next Executive call. TOPP has been priority, so there may not have been much movement.

Members suggested other ideas as well. The CACS will extend an invitation to Jon Veley of the NOP to join a future CACS call to talk about Customs and Border Protections' (CBP) roles and abilities).

- **Executive Meeting Recap.** The CACS Chair presented four work agenda items to the Executive Committee during the December call and all four were approved by both the Executive team and the NOP. See table below.
- Oversight to Deter fraud: Parcel Identification (ADB/NPP). The lead presented background information about parcels and reporting such info to the Farm Service Agency (FSA). The group discussed collection and consistency in data, various existing processes, regulations, guidance, etc., and will discuss this more with the intention of bringing a discussion document to the Spring 2023 meeting. The NOP added that the word field is defined in § 205.2, and parcel is not, and for consistency it might be helpful to use the word field.
- Work Agenda Request: Overview of "Why organic" (JD). The lead described the proposed project and members discussed the goals and the way forward. The CACS Chair added that the National Organic Program does not receive marketing dollars even though it is part of the Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS).
