








USDA Foods FY16 NSLP Purchases




FY16- Total Pounds












Nutrition/Allergen/Ingredient Questions

Can you tell me if this product contains [high fructose corn syrup, gelatin, corn oil, MSG, sulfites, partially hydrogenated oils, azodicarbonamide, caramel color]?
