## Methodology: Regulated Plant List

Current Federal Milk Marketing order numbers: 1 - Northeast, 5 - Appalachian, 6 - Florida, 7 - Southeast, 30 - Upper Midwest, 32 - Central, 33 - Mideast, 51 - California, 124 - Pacific Northwest, 126 - Southwest, and 131 - Arizona.

Historic orders no longer in place or with a different name: 131 - Arizona-Las Vegas, and 135 - Western.

**Regulated Plant Lists** are milk plants, often defined as "handlers," who are regulated under the Federal Milk Marketing Orders. Market Administrators in each Federal Order compile monthly lists of milk plants that meet the qualification criteria defined in CFR§1000, which defines the regulations for the Federal Orders.

The regulated plant list report is updated monthly as data are submitted by the individual Orders to the Market Information Branch of the AMS Dairy Program. This report lists the number of Federal Orders under which each plant is regulated for the particular month. Although a plant cannot be regulated under more than one order in the same month, some plants may be regulated by one order one month and then be regulated under another order the following month.

The regulated plant list report lists both regulated pool distributing plants and regulated pool supply plants. Pool **distributing** plants package and distribute Class I fluid milk products. Pool **supply** plants supply pool distributing plants with Grade A milk as the need arises. The exact qualification standards and criteria for these two groups of regulated milk handling entities are defined in the statute for each Federal Milk Marketing Order (See CFR §1000 for each Order).

Every effort is made to reflect the actual plant name and ownership. Some milk plants, although owned and operated by a parent company, do business under a more traditional and locally known business name. The Market Information Branch, therefore, cannot guarantee that all business names and ownership are correct and makes revisions when new information becomes available.

Each of the regulated milk plants listed are required, and have a legal obligation, to make payments for milk based upon the county location where each plant is physically located. As such, the regulated plant list also lists the Class I differential for the county within which the plant is physically located.

Occasionally, revisions are also made when auditors discover a plant meets (or does not meet) the regulatory criteria for the month or months associated.
