



### Reporting Delivered Cattle on the LS-114

Issue: Some plants may buy a large number of cattle from one producer and these cattle may be delivered over a period of several hours.

LGMN Position: Packers may buy a large number of cattle, at one price, from one producer and these cattle are normally entered into their system as one lot when they are committed. This same lot ID will be tied to the cattle throughout the whole reporting process. These cattle may deliver over a period of several hours and may even run into the next day. LGMN understands that multiple loads from one producer may deliver throughout the day and this presents a challenge as to when to report this one lot as delivered. Packers will submit these transactions to LGMN on the LS-114 as delivered when the last load arrives at the plant.

LGMN Guidance: Packers will not be in violation of the act if they submit these large lots to LGMN when the last load delivers.
