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AMS's Role in Wholesale Pork Reporting

Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS) administers the Livestock Mandatory Reporting (LMR) Act of 1999 and its regulations

- For wholesale pork, there are 4 daily and 12 weekly LMR reports
- Companies are audited to ensure accuracy of data
- Preserves confidentiality of transactions



Who submits wholesale pork data to AMS?

- Federally inspected plants that slaughter or process an average of 100,000 barrows and gilts or 200,000 sows and boars annually
- 55 plants report all transactions of hog purchases and pork sales
- LMR captures 96% of the hog and pork industry



What pork items are submitted?

• Fresh and frozen primals

• Pork trimmings

• Sub-primals

• Pork for processing

 Cuts fabricated from subprimals

• Variety meats



When and How do firms submit sales?

- Twice per weekday at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. Central Time
- Companies electronically submit their records in a single batch file
- Daily LMR wholesale pork reports are published 1 hour after the data is submitted



What does each submission include?

- **Destination** domestic, export/overseas, NAFTA (USMCA)
- Class Code barrow/gilt, sow, boar, mixed

- Sales Type negotiated, forward, formula
- Delivery Period
- Refrigeration

- Product Code
- Total Weight in pounds
- FOB Plant Price \$/cwt.
- FOB Omaha Price \$/cwt.



What is the Reporter's role?

- On average, there are 10,000 wholesale pork records submitted each day
- The Reporters review the data and work with plant personnel to verify orders as needed
 - May be due to high or low price, odd weight, etc.
- Must review, verify, and publish data within 1 hour

 - Released in the Morning (LM_PK600) and Afternoon (LM_PK602)
- National Daily Pork Report FOB Omaha Negotiated Sales
 - Released in the Morning (LM_PK601) and Afternoon (LM_PK603)

What is the cutout?

- The <u>pork carcass cutout value</u> is the estimated value of a standardized pork carcass based upon industry-average cut yields and average market prices of sub-primal pork cuts
- Packaging, fabrication, and labor costs are deducted from the cutout value
- The fabrication yields are provided to USDA by packers covered under LMR
- Yields are updated the first Monday in January



What factors impact the <u>Daily</u> and <u>Weekly</u> **Negotiated** pork carcass cutout calculation?

- Destination domestic and NAFTA
- Sales Type negotiated
- Delivery Period 0-14 days for boxed, 0-10 days for combo
- **Refrigeration** fresh only; 0-10 for boxed, 0-6 for combo
- Class barrows/gilts
