

Instructions to Industry for Completing the Model Health Certificate - Breaking Stock to the European Union

Information for this document was sourced from Document, Chapter 4 of Annex I:
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General

- Applicable boxes must be ticked or marked with a cross (x).
- Where a box is not compulsory, its content shall appear in strike-through.
- Only one of the options may be selected in boxes I.18 and I.20.
- Only one box from boxes I.21 to I.23 may be selected.
- Where a box allows one or more options to be selected, only the selected option(s) will be displayed in the electronic version of the certificate.
- EU Certificates must be signed by USDA no later than the date of departure listed in field I.14, while the eggs are still on American soil. Certificates will not be signed on weekends or federal holidays.

PART I – DESCRIPTION OF CONSIGNMENT

Country: This field is pre-completed.

I.1 Consignor/Exporter

Indicate the name and address, and country of the natural or legal person dispatching the consignment. This should be the same as the Shipper/Seller field on the LP-210S Certificate. Enter “USA” under ISO country code.

I.2 Certificate reference

Enter the SEA number from the LP-210S Certificate, including the letters SEA

I.2a IMSOC reference

Do not complete this field.

I.3 Central competent authority

This field is pre-completed.

I.4 Local competent authority

Do not complete this field.

I.5 Consignee/Importer

Enter the name, address, country, and ISO Country Code for the importer. This should be the same as the Receiver/Buyer field on the LP-210S

I.6 Operator responsible for the consignment

Do not complete this field.

I.7 Country of origin

This field is pre-completed.

I.8 Region of origin

Do not complete this field.

I.9 Country of destination

Indicate the name and ISO country code of Member State of destination of the shipment.

I.10 Region of destination

Do not complete this field.

I.11 Place of dispatch

Indicate the name and address, country and ISO country code of the origin processor. Where required by Union legislation, indicate its registration or approval number.

I.12 Place of destination

Indicate the name and address, country and ISO country code, of the place where the consignment is being delivered for final unloading. Where applicable, also indicate the registration or approval number of the establishment of destination. This may or may not match the Receiver/Buyer field on the LP-210S

I.13 Place of loading

Indicate the city and state of the final place where the products are to be loaded in the means of transport for the journey to the European Union. In the case of a container, state where it is to be placed aboard the final means of transport to the European Union.

I.14 Date and time of departure

Enter the date when the final means of transport departs (aircraft or vessel)

I.15 Means of transport

Select one or more of the following means of transport for the eggs leaving the country of dispatch and its identification code.

I.16 Entry Border Control Post

Indicate the name of the BCP of entry into the Union.

I.17 Accompanying documents

Do not complete this field.

I.18 Transport conditions

Indicate "Chilled" when shipping shell eggs.

I.19 Container number/Seal number

Indicate the container number(s) and seal number(s).

I.20 Certified as or for

This box is prefilled.

I.21 For transit

Do not complete this field.

I.22 For internal market

This box is prefilled.

I.23 For re-entry

Do not complete this field.

I.24 Total number of packages

Enter the number of cases or pallets in the shipment, without converting to 30 dozen equivalents.

I.25 Total quantity

Enter the total number of eggs in the shipment.

I.26 Total net weight/gross weight (kg)

Enter the total net and gross weights of the shipment. These should be transcribed from the LP-210S Remarks section.

I.27 Description of consignment**Cn Code, Species, Subspecies / Category**

0407.21.00

Gallus domesticus

Shell Eggs (Class B)

Number and type of packaging

Cold store

If the eggs are held at an offsite cold storage location prior to being loaded at the port, enter the approval number of the establishment. Otherwise, enter "N/A"

Net Weight

Enter the same net weight in Kilograms as listed in I.26

Number of Packages

Enter the number of cases or pallets in the shipment

Batch No

Enter the oldest Julian date of production

Final consumer

This box should not be ticked for Class B Eggs intended for breaking stock or other industrial use

Date of collection/production

Enter the oldest date of collection/production

Manufacturing plant

Enter the P-#### where the shipment was processed.

PART II – CERTIFICATION

Country

This field is pre-filled

Certificate E

Enter the same number as in field I.2 on page 1.

II. Health information

This field will be completed by USDA.

II.2a Certificate reference

This is the unique alphanumeric code indicated in box I.2.

II.2b IMSOC reference

Do not complete this field.

Certifying officer/Official Veterinarian

USDA Will complete this field.
