## SERVICE FEES AND BILLING CODES

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## **1. PURPOSE**

This Directive transmits the fee schedule and billing codes for official services performed by the Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS), Federal Grain Inspection Service (FGIS), under the United States Grain Standards Act (USGSA), and the Agricultural Marketing Act (AMA) of 1946.

## **2. REPLACEMENT HIGHLIGHTS**

This directive revises the fee schedule for rice inspection per Federal Register (89 FR 37160), dated May 6, 2024, with changes effective October 1, 2024.

This directive all removes the rice rate codes R7AFLA, R7INOA, R7OCHA, and R7YMLD and commodity rate codes CTLMEL, CTLANTI, and CTLELEM.

This directive supersedes FGIS Directive 9180.74, dated July 8, 2024.

This directive corrects fees on Attachment 5 found on pages 15 and 16.

## **3. AUTHORITIES**

The United States Grain Standards Act, as amended

The Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946

Title 7, Code of Federal Regulations, Parts 800 and 868

## **4. POLICY**

Fees assessed by FGIS for official services shall be reasonable, nondiscriminatory, and cover the estimated cost of the service. These costs include direct, administrative, and supervisory costs related to these services.

<sup>3</sup> If a requested test is to be reported on a specified moisture basis, a fee for a moisture test will also be assessed.

<sup>4</sup> Laboratory tests referenced in Table 2 of this section will be charged at the applicable laboratory fee.
