BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH:

Over a long and distinguished career, Dr. Capps has been at the forefront of research on consumer demand issues and econometric modeling and forecasting methods, particularly involving large databases. His research approach is a unique blend of theory-based econometric methodology and applications. He has published groundbreaking work concerning uses of scanning-derived information for managerial decision-making in food retailing; the analysis of expenditure patterns of people eating foods and foods eaten away from home; the analysis of the food demand impacts of health and nutrition information; the unilateral price effects of mergers and acquisitions; and the evaluation of generic commodity advertising and promotion programs. His moniker is "an academician with a competitive mentality."

Currently Executive Professor, Regents Professor and holder of the Southwest Dairy Marketing Endowed Chair in the Department of Agricultural Economics at Texas A&M University as well as Co-Director of the Agribusiness, Food, and Consumer Economics Research Center (AFCERC), Dr. Capps was educated at Virginia Tech. He earned a B.S. degree in Mathematics in 1975, a M.S. degree in Agricultural Economics in 1977, a second M.S. degree in Statistics in 1979, and a Ph.D. degree in Agricultural Economics in December 1979. He has authored 159 refereed journal articles and co-authored four books. Over the period 2008 to present, he has conducted nearly 70 seminars in applied econometrics for the SAS Institute, Inc. From 1995 to 2014, Dr. Capps conducted 65 seminars in applied econometrics, time-series analysis, and forecasting for the National Association of
