- (10) SOUTH CAROLINA, NORTH CAROLINA, VIRGINIA, WEST VIRGINIA, MARYLAND, DELAWARE, DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA
- (11) MEXICO
- (12) QUEBEC, NEW BRUNSWICK, NOVA SCOTIA
- (13) MANITOBA, ONTARIO, NU NAVUT
- (14) BRITISH COLUMBIA, ALBERTA, SASKATCHEWAN, YUKON, NORTHWEST TERRITORIES
