

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


In the box marked “Enter part of the company name:” type in part of the name for the company that you are searching for. For example, if you are searching for an audit of the Cherry Lake Farm, enter “Cherry”. Then hit the Enter key, left click on the down arrow by the box marked “Company”, select Cherry Lake Farm, and click on “View Report”.



You will then have a list of all audits, by audit type and commodity, for the selected company.



D. For the [list by Audit Type, Commodity, Location, and Company Name](#):

This is what you will see when you visit this site.



The initial report that appears will list all audits in the system. For a report with specific parameters, select the choices that will provide you with the report that you wish to create, using the following boxes: "Audit Types", "Commodity Category", "Commodity Subcategories", "Commodities", "Location Category", "Location", and "Company". You must click in each box, and make a selection, in order to obtain a final report.

To obtain a report, click on "View Report". A multi-page report is generated, with entries listed by audit sections. You can scroll through the various pages using the arrows next to the page numbers.

You can export the report by selecting a format and then clicking on "Export" (see screen shots in Section A.).
