# Organic *INTEGRITY* Database Update and Next Steps

## INTEGRITY Launch = Significant Success

- USDA ORGANIC
- Significant certifier input helped shape development and testing
- As of lunchtime, 71 certifiers have data in the system (representing >94% of operations)
- A significant number of certifiers used the taxonomy in their initial data submittal
- Many certifiers have indicated that they will adopt taxonomy over next year and will be making frequent updates to system

### Where We Are NOW

- We are ALL still learning what INTEGRITY does and how to use it
- We have gone from 1 layer of data to 3:
  - Basic Search
  - Advanced Search
  - Operation Profile
- There are many operation-scope-product certification status roll-up and roll-down rules to accommodate different certifier needs

# Don't Like Something?

- It could be a decision we made based on NOP, certifier, and stakeholder input
- It could be an unexpected derivative outcome caused by a related decision
- It could be an error in assumptions during programming
- It could be a bug (something was coded incorrectly)

## What Happens to Feedback



- We classify concern: Bug? Request?
  - Includes assessing whether it is an individualized or shared need or want
- We assess action plan:
  - Plan to implement as maintenance step
  - List as new accepted need to schedule
  - List as something to consider in the future
- User group will be consulted once things settle down and we have a stable list

## What We Ask YOU to Focus On



- Increased data structure and visibility is highlighting data quality problems
- It is also highlighting new policy questions

#### Focus on:

- Getting used to using the system
- Uploading replacement lists as needed
- Using user interface to fix individual operation data and upload new ones
- Getting used to changing certification statuses when operation is suspended or revoked

## **Certifier Scenario 1**

- Changing certification status to suspended or revoked when issuing Final Notices
- Uploading new operations monthly
- Changing status from certification to surrendered monthly
  - Using user interface if there are few
  - Uploading operation level data sheet if there are many

## **Certifier Scenario 2**

- Focusing on refining export from existing certification system into the new template
- Plans to upload spreadsheet every week or two with any updated data

# Into Mid/Long-Term



Operation
Reinstatement

- Ensure Suspended Operations are not Re-Certified without Reinstatement
- Track Operation Certification Status
   Changes Over Time

Adverse Action Postings

- Integrate Adverse Action Reporting into INTEGRITY
- Align Adverse Action Reporting with Certification Status Changes in Database

Operation Certificate Module

- Transition to Federated Certificate
  Template to Reduce Fraud
- Facilitate Certifier Production of Certificates through INTEGRITY or on Own

### **Some Notes About Certificate Module**



- We know many certifiers have concerns
- We are NOT trying to eliminate unique sources of value for certifier
- We ARE seeking more harmonization and a shared look across the industry
- We ARE seeking to increase market security
- We'd also like to capitalize on the standardized look-up potential offered by the new and permanent NOP ID (10 digits)
