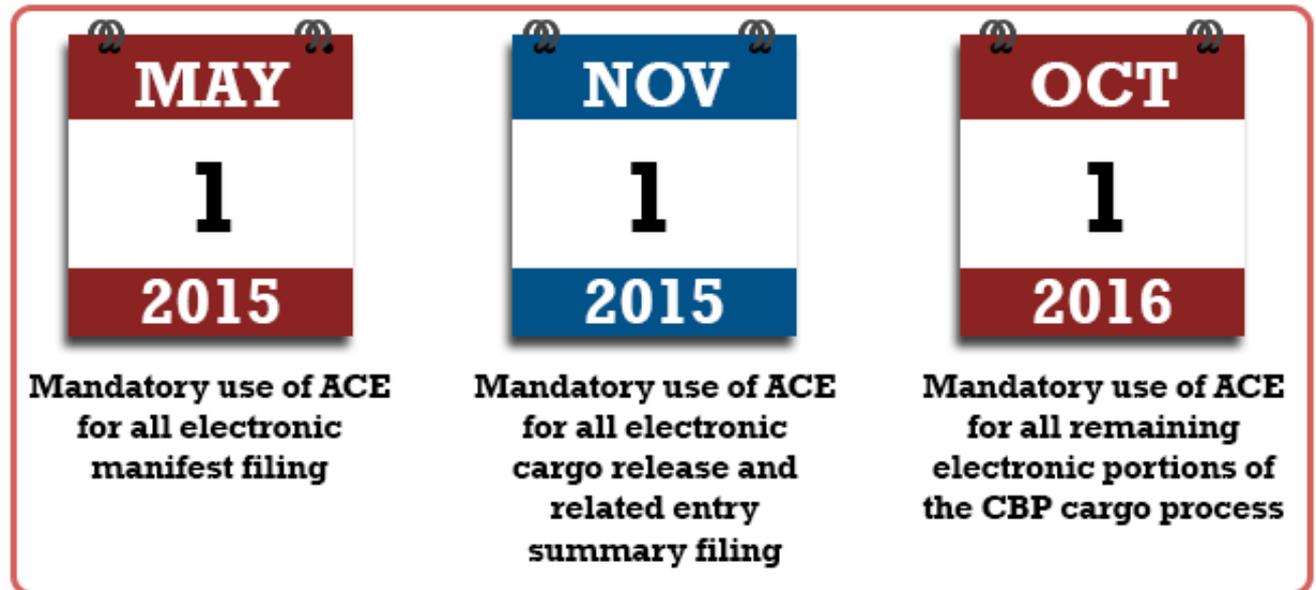
# ITDS/ACE

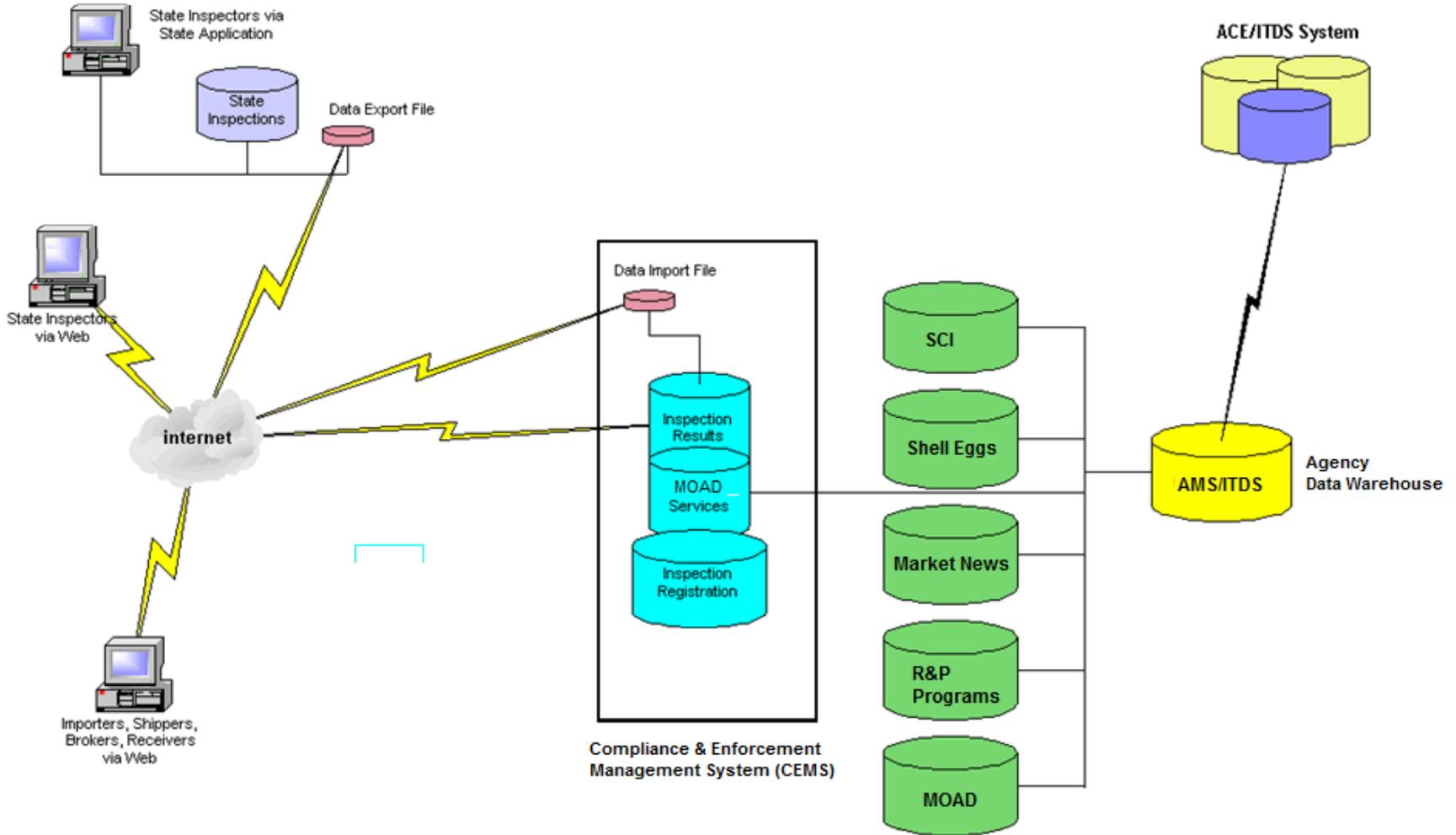
## Automated Commercial Environment

- Customs Modernization Act of 1993
- Single, centralized access point for government and trade community
