



Certifying Agents Approved to Issue TM-11 Export Certificates under an Export Arrangement between the USDA and a Foreign Government

When exported to Japan and Taiwan, U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) organic products must be accompanied by an organic export certificate (TM-11). The TM-11 verifies that the product complies with the terms of the trade partnership. All USDA National Organic Program accredited certifying agents (certifiers) may issue TM-11 certificates to Japan.

Taiwan only

Certifiers must be approved by the USDA to issue TM-11 export certificates for exports going to Taiwan. This document lists authorized certifiers, as well as their assigned acronyms:
