

**NOSB Recommendation on Mushroom Practice Standards  
As Amended at the NOSB Meeting  
October 17, 2001**

***Mushroom Standards***

Mr. Sideman motioned to adopt the mushroom standards as written.

Mr. Bandele proposed an amendment adding the following sentence: "Agricultural material[s] such as grain or straw that are used in uncomposted media must be organically produced when commercially available." The amendment failed, 7 opposed, 6 in favor, with 2 absent.

Mr. Harper proposed an amendment changing language on sawdust to read, "Sawdust, logs or other materials derived from wood used as a growth media must not have been treated with a prohibited substance." The amendment failed, 8 opposed, 3 in favor, 2 abstaining, 2 absent.

Mr. Lockeretz proposed a friendly amendment changing the word "media" to "medium."

Bob Pooler called for a vote on the motion as modified by the friendly amendment, and the motion passed, 11 in favor, 1 opposed, 1 abstention, 2 absent.
