I am writing to request and brief extension of time to submit comments and alternative proposals to the hearing requests submitted by National Milk Producers Federation and International Dairy Foods Association. As you are aware, in conjunction with Nancy Bryson and Al Ricciardi, I have been discussing the NMPF/IDFA proposals with several affected producer-handler organizations.
