Mailbox price does include, for the most part, the assessment under the Cooperatives Working Together (CWT) program.

² Information is shown for those areas for which prices are reported for at least 75% of the milk marketed under Federal milk orders. The price shown is the weighted average of the prices reported for all orders that received milk from that area.

³ Figures are annual averages - the weighted average of the monthly figures; except California, which is the simple average.
