

AMENDMENT 4 TO THE COTTON STORAGE AGREEMENT (CSA)

NOTE: The following statement is made in accordance with the Privacy Act of 1974 (5 USC 552a – as amended). The authority for requesting the information identified on this form is 7 CFR Part 1423, 7 CFR Part 1427, the Commodity Credit Corporation Charter Act (15 U.S.C. 714 et seq.), and the Agricultural Act of 2014 (Pub. L. 113-79). The information will be used to determine eligibility to participate in and receive benefits under a storage of CCC-interest cotton program through documentation of warehouse operator acknowledgement of, and agreement to, the terms and conditions of an amended Cotton Storage Agreement. The information collected on this form may be disclosed to other Federal, State, Local government agencies, Tribal agencies, and nongovernmental entities that have been authorized access to the information by statute or regulation and/or as described in applicable Routine Uses identified in the System of Records Notice for USDA/FSA-2, Farm Records File (Automated) and USDA/FSA-3, Consultants File. Providing the requested information is voluntary. However, failure to furnish the requested information will result in a determination of ineligibility to participate in and receive benefits under a storage of CCC-interest cotton program.

The Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC) and (2) _____ (warehouse operator or contractor) hereby agree to amend the CSA as follows:

Part 3. S. (2) (a) is amended to read as follows:

PART 3 - WAREHOUSE OPERATOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES

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- (a) BMAS, defined as any cotton bales that:
- (i) with respect to the relevant week of the report (1) have been delivered; or (2) are scheduled and ready for delivery during such week, and;
 - (ii) were scheduled and ready for delivery in a previous week, but were not picked up by the shipper and remain available for immediate loading and, (1) another shipping date has not been arranged for such bales; or (2) such bales are not subject to a restocking fee as provided in the warehouse's public tariff, and;
 - (iii) were made available, but not picked up by the shipper, can only be reported by the warehouse operator as BMAS for no longer than the first 2 weeks that such bales have been made available for delivery but have not yet been picked up.
